The Brussels office of the Dublin Regional Authority and the [Irish delegation](#) to the Committee of the Regions.

The main functions of the Dublin Regional Authority are:

- To promote co-ordination and where appropriate co-operation, joint action, joint arrangements, agreements, communication or consultation between local authorities, public agencies and other persons in the region, with regard to the provision of public services.
- To promote consideration by public authorities of the regional perspective of their activities, decision and services.
- To review from time to time the overall needs and development requirements of the region.
- To review from time to time the development plans of the local authorities in the region and insofar as they may be relevant, the development plans of local authorities in adjoining regions. This must be undertaken with particular regard to the consistency of such plans with one another and the overall needs and development requirements of the region.
- To keep under review the provision of public services in or relating to or affecting the region and the needs for adequacy of, and possibilities of improving co-ordination of the provision of such services.

Within two years of its establishment and thereafter at least one in every 5 years, prepare a regional report covering the region's needs and development requirements, the provision and co-ordination of public services, the consistency of local authority development plans and other related matters considered appropriate
